-**Paul Klee** (18 December 1879 - 29 June 1940) was born in Switzerland, and is considered both a German and a Swiss painter.

-In 1898, Paul Klee went to the Academy of Fine Arts in Munich, Germany.

-In 1914, Paul went to Tunisia. He began drawing abstract art. This means that instead of painting objects as they actually looked, he used colour and marks to represent the objects. Paul felt that he now understood how to use colour and had finally become a painter.

Word	Definition
<b>Monochromatic colour scheme</b>	Monochromatic (or mono) is <b>a colour scheme based on only one, single colour</b> . It uses variations (shades) and (tints).
<b>Tint</b>	Tint refers to any colour to which white is added. Pastel colours are generally tinted colours. Tinted colour remains the same colour, but it is paler than the original.
<b>Shade</b>	Shade is colour to which only black is added. It contains no white or grey. Shade darkens the colour, but the hue remains the same. When mixing a shade, begin with the colour itself then add black one drop at a time.
