Word	Definition
Mono Printing	Monoprinting is a one-off fine art printing technique that uses a sheet of paper/perspex to transfer a unique design onto a sheet of paper. No two monoprints are alike, and the design created can only be used once ('mono' = single).
Focal point	A focal point is the most visually interesting area of the composition. There can be multiple focal points, within a composition.
