Investigate- We looked at existing Christmas jumpers and considered which designs we did or did not like.

- **Design-** We considered which fabrics and joining techniques we might want to use on our product.

- Using sketches and labels, we designed different models of Christmas jumpers. From this, we chose the best design, which we based our final product on.

- Using appropriate fabric and fastenings, we made a Christmas jumper.
